### The objective of the seminar




- demonstrating what SEE programme & projects have achieved



#### **Global objective**

Improvement of the territorial, economic and social integration process and contribution to cohesion, stability and competitiveness through the development of transnational partnerships and joint actions on matters of strategic importance

Promotion of sustainable development

#### Specific objectives

Facilitation of innovation, entrepreneurship, knowledge economy and information society by concrete cooperation action and visible results

Improvement of the attractiveness of regions and cities taking into account sustainable development, physical and knowledge accessibility and environmental quality by integrated approaches and concrete cooperation action and visible results

Foster integration by supporting balanced capacities for transnational territorial cooperation at all levels

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# Territorial cooperation 2014-2020 Comission position



- Support for development & implementation of Macro Regional Strategies
  - Danube & Adriatic regions
- Synergies between programmes to be promoted
- Simplification incl. greater harmonisation of rules
- Specific rules for the application of State Aid
- Coverage of regions both inside and outside EU
- Thematic concentration
  - limited no. of thematic objectives (4/11)
  - 1 priority axis = 1 thematic objective



## Thematic objectives - Comission proposal



- 1. Strengthening research, technological development and innovation
- 2. Enhancing access to, and use and quality of, information and communication technologies
- 3. Enhancing the competitiveness of small and medium-sized enterprises, the agricultural sector (for the EAFRD) and the fisheries and aquaculture sector (for the EMFF)
- 4. Supporting the shift towards a low-carbon economy in all sectors
- 5. Promoting climate change adaptation, risk prevention and management
- 6. Protecting the environment and promoting resource efficiency
- 7. Promoting sustainable transport and removing bottlenecks in key network infrastructures
- 8. Promoting employment and supporting labour mobility
- 9. Promoting social inclusion and combating poverty
- 10. Investing in education, skills and lifelong learning mon future
- 11. Enhancing institutional capacity and an efficient public administration

#### **Regulation proposals**

### **Priority Axis 1 Facilitation of innovation and entrepreneurship**

Strengthening research, technological development and innovation (Theme 1) Enhancing research and innovation infrastructure (R&I) and capacities to develop R&I excellence and Promoting centres of competence, in particular those of European interest

Promoting business R&I investment, product and Service development, technology transfer, social innovation and public service applications, demand stimulation, networking, clusters and open innovation through smart specialization

Supporting technological and applied research, pilot lines, early product validation actions, advanced Manufacturing capabilities and first production in Key Enabling Technologies and diffusion of general purpose technologies

Enhancing the Competitiveness of SMEs (Theme 3)
