Overview

The field of agriculture currently faces immense challenges, including the pressure to provide food security and safety despite the ongoing financial crises and climate changes. Meeting these challenges will require considerable efforts and research expertise, especially in less developed agricultures such as in the Republic of Serbia and other Western Balkan countries. The aim of the AREA project is to improve existing and introduce new research expertise at the Faculty of Agriculture, which will precisely target some of the mentioned challenges in various areas of agriculture and food production. TITLE: font Arial, bold, size 12, capital letters, centered.

AUTHOR(S): font Arial, size12, centered, Surname, Name. Affiliations numbered in superscript.

INSTITUTION AND ADDRESS: font Arial, size 12, Italic, centered, Institution, City, Country, e-mail: presenting author.

ABSTRACT TEXT: font Arial, size 12, justified, single spaces, maximum 500 words.

Keywords: maximum of 5 keywords, font Arial, Italic, size 12, left aligned.
