Identified challenges in the Western Balkan Region

Access to Excellence

- > Inward looking and fragmentation vs. International vision and opening;
- Outdated R&D infrastructure vs. improving access to modern research facilities and funds for mission-driven research;
- ➤ Low **impact** of **R&D** activities at country and regional level;
- > Brain drain vs. increase of attractiveness and creating conditions for talents, mobilising and levereging of diaspora.
- ➤ Need for **cultural** and **innovation** vision **shift** at 360°;

Access to Programmes

- > Low absorption of EU programmes and funding due to the lack of capacity and knowledge;
- Low or no strategic participation to relevant EU networks;
- ➤ Low use of research mobility schemes and fellowship programs for international collaboration;
- > Learning mode, difficulties to exit from the comfort zone;
- > Victim syndrome instead of being proactive and take ownership of actions.

Access to Funding

- > Traditional vs. innovative financing;
- Inability to mobilise publicprivate partnerships;
- > Difficulty to introduce equity and quasi-equity instruments:
- Inability to mobilise private investors and Business Angels.





Access to Excellence= Uptake of H2020 and future FP9 programme

- > Mapping of the existing strategies, action plans, support measures and programmes as well as of target stakeholders;
- > Mapping of pocket of excellence as well as of the gaps and challenges;
- > Based on the mapping, the roadmap will be drafted providing list of actions aligned with the stakeholders in charge;
- > A series of workshops and capacity building acitivities to be organised and delivered on the topic related to the absortpion of EU funding and programmes: how to set up proper measures and support structures; how to set up and organise a proper EU back office; relevance of EU networks and building of visibility; how to succesful proposal, prepare a impact. elements related to evaluation, building of a consortium and partner search; sustainability.

Access to Programmes=Impact of Research

- ➤ Implementation of Research helicopter 5 module programme:
 Analysis of Exploitation risks (AER);
 Exploitation Strategy Seminars (ESS);
 Business Plan Development (BPD);
 Brokerage and pitching events (BPE),
 Patenting.
- The aim to be achieved is to bridge the gap between research outcomes and commercial products on the one hand, and researchers and businessmen on the other, using a series of tailored, on demand services.
- Moreover, the exploitation has become a crucial element in FP7 and H2020 projects and is a mandatory activity and reporting item.

Access to Funding=Attracting funding resources for research and innovation

- Mapping of the existing financial instruments, supporting measures and programmes;
- Implementation of capacity building on:
 - Why equity financial instruments are needed
 - What are the requirement for designing a sound Equity Financial Instrument
 - How to attract private investors
 - How to design an equity financial instrument

The overall aim is to make equity finance more used for start-up creation (attracting private resources to research and innovation).


