Foresight exercise

- Keynote on Foresight held at Ministerial Meeting 2.12.2020, discussion with WB Ministers
- Flyer on the Strategic Foresight Initiative with summaries of draft scenarios in English;
 translations into Albanian, Bosnian, Macedonian and Serbian finalised and distributed
- Scenarios were further adapted based on your Ministers' feedback, and on in-depth feedback
 by the JRC Strategic Foresight experts incl. on Delphi Survey
- Delphi Survey currently being prepared, translated and planned to be launched possibly next week to the contacts provided (thank you!)

- Draft ERA profiles (September 2020 update) submitted to EC and under revision
- Questionnaire sent out to WB6 for written contributions before today's meeting
- Next steps: updates to be prepared for March 2021 (with your and experts' feed back)
- New ERA Communication by the EC with 4 strategic objectives and 14 actions reporting under Horizon Europe in the upcoming months

- 3 virtual WB Research & Innovation meetings (June, July and September 2020)
- 2 virtual WB Steering Platform meetings (14 October and 25 November 2020)
 and collaboration with DG EAC for two additional events
- Virtual Ministerial Meeting of the WB SP on Education and Training & Research and Innovation on 2 December 2020
- Next steps: virtual meetings on 27 January 2021, upcoming in March, April, June, September 2021;
 Ministerial Meeting in May 2021 for adoption of the Joint Declaration;
 If possible also a physical meeting in Summer 2021.



■ Study on S3

Updates on ISF activities

- S3 inception report developed in coordination with JRC and EC; video & phone interviews ongoing
- S3 study will focus individually and for the entire macro-region including the 6 economies on :
 - Policy implementation system (Institutions, stakeholders, policy planning cycles, sectoral strategies)
 - Financing system (policies, planning, distribution)
 - Reporting monitoring and evaluation system (legal rules, capacities and preparedness, evaluation practice)
 - Cluster in S3 (cluster landscape and actors, specific economic niches, outreach)
 - Cluster management (services, funding, planning, monitoring and reporting, international knowledge exchange)
 - Macro-regional coord. activities (relevance, benefits, interaction focus, future potential and options)
- A draft will be available beginning of March 2021 and can be presented during a meeting in 2021



Visibility and Dissemination

- Initial plan to integrate promotion of WB R&I communities into 3 major EU R&I (virtual) events;
 need to re-design the activity due to COVID-19:
 - Only ESOF2020 could be attended in Sept 2020, 2 Sessions; social media campaign including videos
 - Next steps: implementation of an online communication and promotional campaign as alternative, to raise awareness on the WBC-RTI.INFO platform and to promote Horizon Europe in WB
- WBC-RTI.INFO platform (first 12 months of activity):
 - 71.800 unique visitors; visits mainly from Europe; mainly Serbia, Albania and North Macedonia
 - 533 news, 194 calls, 209 events, 216 documents, 63 links published
 - Newsletter: 15 bulletins sent to 11.300 stakeholders; focus on: Ministerial Meeting, WB Innovation Agenda, Digital Balkans, ERA developments, Science Diplomacy, H2020 and MSCA, etc. ...
 - Next steps: continuation of online information and newsletter services
