EIT MAIN ACTIVITY AREAS

- EDUCATION: educating the next generation of entrepreneurs, innovators & change-makers
- EIT BUSINESS CREATION & ACCELERATION: tailored support for entrepreneurs and ventures
- INNOVATION DRIVEN RESEARCH PROJECTS: transdisciplinary co-creation and responsivity to market and social trends







EIT IN THE WESTERN BALKANS

- In 2014-2020, and the EIT Community channelled over €1.6m to the Western Balkans, supporting 13 unique local partner organisations working on innovation projects, as well as, 34 ventures which jointly raised over €9m in investment.
- Four different **EIT Hubs** are currently established in the Western Balkan region.
- In 2021-2027, the EIT will give priority to its engagement with the Western Balkans, especially through the enhanced EIT RIS, a Cross-KIC action supporting Strategic Regional Innovations and the EIT Action to Support the Innovation Capacity of Higher Education Institutions.
- Synergies with IPA III & other organisations / initiatives are in place or being sought.





EIT REGIONAL INNOVATION SCHEME (EIT RIS)

Objective

Enhance the innovation capacity in moderate and modest innovators
 Member States, eligible Horizon Europe Associated Countries and EU
 Outermost Regions

Approach

- Capacity building activities and closer interactions between the local knowledge triangle innovation actors and their activities
- Widen participation in EIT Innovation Communities, including through RIS Hubs
- Strengthen links to Smart Specialisation Strategies and leverage additional private and public funding, especially ESI Funding.
- Budget: 10-15% of the EIT grant allocated to EIT RIS activities







EIT Cross-KIC Regional Strategic Innovations Cluster

- EIT Cross-KIC Regional Strategic Innovations Cluster brings together all 8 EIT KICs to jointly implement support activities targeted Emerging European regions, including the Western Balkans.
- The EIT Jumpstarter pre-accelerator programme is a key initiative of the Cross-KIC Cluster. It supports early-stage idea holders through tailored trainings and mentoring which help them to validate their business model and prepare them for the next steps in their entrepreneurial journey, including via the EIT KICs' individual accelerator programmes. EIT Jumpstarter also provides a knowledge and international network to researchers to commercialise their products.
- A dedicated Western Balkans initiative under the Cross-KIC Regional Strategic Innovations Cluster is being explored to kick-off in 2023.





EIT HEI Initiative Innovation Capacity Building For Higher Education

Objective:

- Create systemic impact by engaging HEIs at institutional level
 - Strengthen the entrepreneurial and innovation capacity of HEIs at institutional level
 - Strengthen integration into innovation ecosystems

First pilot Call Results:

• 32 countries, 24 projects x 1.2 Million (2021-2023)

Next steps:

- 2nd Call was open until 28 February 2022!
- 40 projects x 1.2 Million max per project (2 years)

EIT-backed Success Stories in the Western Balkans

Several start-ups from the Western Balkans have been nurtured through the **EIT Jumpstarter** including three which have gone on to win prizes in the programme's Grand Final:

- Green and Clean Tech (Serbia);
- Fejuice (Serbia); and;
- Horizer (Bosnia-Herzegovina).

Many others have gone on to receive smart financing investment and mentoring support from the KICs' Accelerator Programmes.



A growing number of EIT-backed start-ups from the Western Balkans are also experiencing significant commercial success. **ElevenEs** is one of these. The start-up has received investment and support from **EIT InnoEnergy** to build a battery gigafactory in **Subotica**, **Serbia**. To date, ElevenEs has raised a total of **EUR500 million in investment** and is on track to deliver **major socio-economic development of this host region**, bringing technological progress, reversing brain drain, attracting international talent and directly creating some 2,000 jobs.
